Welcome to a new academic year, all the pupils have been admitted and are settling in nicely. 
The school has a buggy/bike/scooter storage area for parents who walk their children to school - do use it when bringing these items to school where they can all be held safely.

We have plenty of clean clothes for the children at the nursery if they need to be changed, could we, therefore, please ask parents not to put backpacks on the coat pegs as this takes up valuable space and impedes the children's independence when getting their coats on for outdoor play.
