

## Early Years Pupil Premium 2016/17

We currently have 14 children attending the nursery who are eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium. We receive funding of £100 each term for each of the children.

Parents of the children receiving EYPP meet with Ms Millett/Mrs Dymoke to discuss the additional funding and how it will be used to meet the individual needs of each child.

Areas for development have been identified as:

- To support the development of listening and attention skills
- To develop children's speech and their use of language
- To support the development of self-confidence and self-esteem
- To support the development of early reading skills

To meet the individual needs of these children we use a number of interventions to include:

- One to one and small group support with learning support staff and key workers to work on confidence and self-esteem
- Additional phonic sessions to reinforce letter of the week and give support and challenge if appropriate
- Access to funded places in after school clubs to meet individual needs identified by key workers and parents
- Differentiated questioning from key workers on an ongoing basis
- Enrichment activities/events for all children to include, Forest School, Story Telling experiences

8 of these children have attended the Nursery since September 2016 and 6 have attended since January 2017
