

Impact of Pupil Premium EYFS funding on 2015/16 cohort

Rationale:

- To close gaps in attainment by accelerating the progress of pupils in receipt of PP funding. Our strategy is to invest in early intervention whenever possible.
- To develop and expand provision to meet the identified needs of individual children through targeted additional support and intervention.
