Health & Safety Notice

Here are few reminders to ensure everyone's Health & Safety whilst on the premises.....

- **GATES** - Could we please remind you to close and secure the gates when entering and leaving the nursery grounds, also emphasise to the children that only grown-ups are allowed to open the gate.
- **GRAPES** - if your child has grapes in their packed lunch could you please ensure they are cut into quarters, lengthwise.
- **YELLOW CONES** - when the ground is icy, the cones are laid out on the black safety surface, this is to ensure ONLY the footpath is used as we cannot 'salt' the safety surface. Please ensure you keep to the footpath.
- If you bring your child to school in a buggy, or they use a scooter or cycle, the school has a designated safe area for parents to leave any of these items on site while your child attends nursery.
- **CAR PARK** Please do not use the school's car park entrance when dropping off or collecting your children.
- **PHONE** Inform the school office if you have changed your phone number as soon as possible.

SCHOOL CLOSURES - please note, if the school has to close due to bad weather conditions, we will post the notification just after 7am onto the school's website - log onto the 'Home Page' of the Weston Way Nursery website then navigate to "News and Dates".
