Objectives for supporting children who receive EYPP for this year:

- To support the development of listening and attention skills
- To develop children's speech and their use of language
- To support the development of self-confidence and self-esteem
- To support the development of early reading skills

Impact:

The % of children in receipt of EYPP funding made greater progress across all area of learning than the whole cohort. The large majority of EYPP pupils entered the nursery at a lower level of attainment but the 'gap has been narrowed' for those children receiving additional funding and the interventions this has enabled the nursery to deliver.
